Flint River Regional Libraries

The Flint River Regional Library (FRRL) invites vendors to submit proposals in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Request for Proposal (RFP). This RFP provides the requirements and evaluative criteria for Internet services and requests a detailed response from all prospective vendors, including pricing and service descriptions, in a specified format.

Our goal is selecting an Internet Service Provider or Internet Services Providers that can provide Internet Access with sufficient speed and bandwidth needed at each or some of the libraries in the Flint River Regional Library.

The work proposed in these specifications are dependent upon receipt of Erate Funding for Internet Access for the Erate Funding Year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021

The intent of this RFP is to enter into a contract or contracts for Internet Access for a three (3) year period to begin July 1, 2018, and run through June 30, 2021. The Flint River Regional Library services shall commence at 12:00:01 a.m. on July 1, 2018.

Background Information

The Flint River Regional Library is headquartered in Griffin, Spalding County, Georgia. The library system consists of 9 libraries within six (6) counties; Butts, Fayette, Lamar, Monroe, Pike, and Spalding. The library system presently has approximately 300 computers in the system and all sites are presently connected via fiber-optic lines to the Internet.

Services required for this RFP

Services sought in a contract resulting from this RFP are as follows:

- Standard Internet Service via fiber-optic cable.
- Static IP address allocation for continued access to IP-based library resources.
- Managed Services, monitoring and support, of the Internet connection to each of the individual libraries.

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Service Provider will provide all necessary equipment, IP addresses, connections, routers, etc. needed for Internet Access at each of the Flint River Regional Libraries.

CIPA (Child Internet Protection Act) compliant content filtering will not be required. Firewalls at each library handle all CIPA compliant content filtering.

The vendor will be responsible for all service, maintenance, support, and monitoring of Internet connections. Prompt response times and on-site repairs during operating hours and proactive monitoring are required.

Troubleshooting service will be provided within four (4) hours of reported problem(s) during library operating hours. Refunds will be provided for periods of service outage lasting more than 12 hours.

Full implementation of Internet service must occur by July 1, 2018.

Current Environment: Flint River Regional Libraries currently have internet service provided through a local contract with Georgia Public Web using fiber-optic lines. The table below outlines current capacity at all library locations.

Proposals should also include bandwidth pricing for additional 10MB increments above the requested bandwidth, up to 100 MB, at each library.

All proposals must include service providers total costs; monthly recurring pricing for Managed Services, transport, and dedicated and synchronous Internet and all fees, for example: USF surcharges, franchise fees, surcharges that may apply, Federal Access Recovery Charges, and any and all other fees, each as separate line items in the proposal by library.

Invoicing – REQUIRE DISCOUNTED BILLING

Vendors submitting responses to this Request for Proposal agree to provide discounted billing for services associated with this proposal and seek reimbursement of the discount amount according to the invoicing/reimbursement guidelines of the Schools and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Fund. Flint River Regional Library System will pay for the discounted portion of services provided under this proposal. Invoices should be broken down by individual library listing the appropriate discounted charge for each contracted facility. Total costs may be listed minus the applicable discount amount to arrive at the discounted amount accounted to each library in the Flint River Regional Library System.

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All invoices must be based on a first-of-the-month through end-of-the-month cycle.

Errors on invoices cannot be remedied by credits on invoices. All errors must be repaid by a check cut by the Service Provider within 30 days of notification of such error.

Service Provider Requirements

SPIN AND FCCRN REQUIRED

It is the intention of the Flint River Regional Libraries to apply for discounts under the Schools and Libraries ("E-Rate") program for all of the services that are the subject of this RFP. Therefore, all Service Providers responding to this RFP must participate in the E-Rate Program and must comply with all applicable FCC rules.

The Service Provider is required to submit its SPIN and FCCRN as part of the Proposal. If you do not have a SPIN and FCCRN, you MUST obtain them before you respond to this RFP.

Document Retention, Production of Records, and Audits

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 54.516, the Service Providers have the following obligations with respect to document retention, production of records and audits:

The Service Providers shall retain documents related to the delivery of discounted telecommunications and other supported services for at least 10 years after the last day of the delivery of discounted services. Any other document that demonstrates compliance with the statutory or regulatory requirements for the schools and libraries mechanism shall be retained as well. Comprehensive information about document retention requirements is found in the FCC's Fifth Report and Order (FCC 04-190).

The Service Providers shall produce such records at the request of any representative (including any auditor) appointed by a state education department, the Administrator, the FCC or any local, state or federal agency with jurisdiction over the entity.

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The Service Providers shall be subject to audits and other investigations to evaluate their compliance with the statutory and regulatory requirements for the schools and libraries universal service support program including those requirements pertaining to what services and products are purchased, what services and products are delivered, and how services and products are being used. Flint River Regional Libraries must provide written consent before a Service Provider releases information to the auditor, reviewer, or other representative.

The Service Provider shall assume responsibility for its subcontractors' compliance with the FCC requirements on document retention, production of records, and auditing.

Lowest Corresponding Price

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 54.511, Service Providers shall not submit bids for or charge Flint River Regional Libraries a price above the lowest corresponding price for supported services, unless the FCC, with respect to interstate services or the state commission with respect to intrastate services, finds that the lowest corresponding price is not compensatory.

Promotional rates offered by a Service Provider for a period of more than 90 days must be included among the comparable rates upon which the lowest corresponding price is determined.

Pricing Transparency

Pursuant to the FCC's E-Rate Modernization Order (FCC14-99) released July 23, 2014, the Commission provided notice to all Service Providers that the receipt of E-Rate support will be conditioned on disclosure of pricing information beginning in Funding Year 2015. The Commission states in the Order that contracts executed after the effective date of the Report and Order may not contain restrictions barring publication of purchasing price data, and that any such restrictions shall have no effect.

Contract Terms & Conditions

The following Terms & Conditions are to be included in contract resulting from this RFP: Flint River Regional Libraries will not sign a vendor contract.

- Services added during the course of the contract must be coterminous with the proposed contract.

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- Flint River Regional Libraries reserves the right to change a Service Provider if there is a legitimate reason to do so.
- Time is of the essence in the Proposed Contract.
- Should the Service Provider, its principals, agents or employees act in violation of the FCC's policy regarding gifts, and should Flint River Regional Libraries be denied funding on a funding request or be subject to a commitment adjustment as a result of the aforementioned action, the Service Provider shall be liable for liquidated damages in the amount of Flint River Regional Libraries discounted portion on each of the funding requests so denied.
- The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable FCC rules, Orders, and guidance which govern the E-Rate program. Notwithstanding any other remedies at law or equity, in the event the Service Provider acts or fails to act in such a way that causes Flint River Regional Libraries to lose E-Rate funding, the Service Provider shall be liable to Flint River Regional Libraries for the amount of denied, reduced or adjusted funding. Additionally, the Service Provider shall be liable to Flint River Regional Libraries for legal or consulting fees Flint River Regional Libraries incurs to: ensure compliance with the E- rate program; to respond to the FCC or USAC directives; and/or to pursue an appeal.

General Conditions

This RFP is not a contract offer. Acceptance of a proposal neither commits the Flint River Regional Library to award a contract to any vendor, even if all requirements stated in this RFP are met, nor limits the library's rights to negotiate in the library's best interests. The Flint River Regional Library reserves the right to contract with a vendor or vendors for reasons other than just price.

Failure to answer any questions in this RFP may subject the proposal to disqualification. Failure to meet qualifications and requirements will not necessarily subject a proposal to disqualification.

It is important that the vendor understand that this Internet Access Proposal has been submitted on Flint River Regional Library Erate applications which, if approved, will entitle us to approximately 90% discount through the Universal Service Fund. Right of Rejection

The Flint River Regional Library reserves the right to accept or reject any or all responses to this RFP and to enter into discussion and/or negotiations with one or more

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qualified vendors at the same time, if such actions are in the best interest of the Flint River Regional Library. FRRL reserves the right to reject any or all proposals or parts thereof, as deemed to be in the best interest of the Library.

Failure to answer any questions in this RFP may subject the proposal to disqualification. Failure to meet qualifications and requirements will not necessarily subject a proposal to disqualification.

Cost of Proposals

Expenses incurred in the preparation of proposals to this RFP are the sole responsibility of the vendor.

Proposals for Specific Libraries, Groups, or Regionally

Bidders may submit proposals for individual libraries or for a group of libraries or for all libraries in the Flint River Regional Library System, as best suits their business and Internet Service Provider capabilities.

PROPOSAL DELIVERY

RFP Submission

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

The Flint River Regional Library may make such investigation as they deem necessary to determine the ability of bidder to perform the work. FRRL reserves the right to reject any proposal if investigation of such bidder fails to satisfy the FRRL that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract, and to complete the work contemplated therein.

Bidders may be required to submit the names and addresses of the officers or principals of the Corporation, firm or partnership submitting a proposal. Failure to comply could result in the rejection of such bid as non-responsive.

All bidders must be prepared to present suitable evidence of their financial standing.

FRRL has the right to reject any and all proposals from any bidder that is in or contemplates bankruptcy of any chapter or nature. Said bidder must notify the Flint River Regional Library in writing of any existing condition or knowledge of same.

No verbal instructions or information to bidders will be binding. The specifications will be considered clear and complete unless written attention is called to any apparent discrepancies or incompleteness thereof, before the opening of bids. Should any written inquiries be received by FRRL, these inquiries will be answered in the question and answer portion of our webpage and posted for access by all providers.

The submission of a bid will be considered as conclusive evidence of complete examination of all instructions and specifications.

A Bid Form - Signature Page is provided in these specifications. This form must be used in submitting a bid, and all pages of the form must be completely filled out, and the whole signed by the bidder.

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No bid may be withdrawn later than 3:00 PM on the day of the opening of bids. No modifications of any bid will be allowed after the same is sealed and delivered to FRRL, however, a bidder may withdraw a proposal before 3:00 PM on the day of the opening of bids and submit another bid before the closing date and time.

FORM OF CONTRACT

The successful bidder will be required to execute a written contract with FRRL within fifteen (15) business days after acceptance of bid. It is expressly understood and agreed by the bidders that the contractual obligations of FRRL to the bidders are effective only after the execution of a contract signed by all parties and E-Rate funding is secured from the School and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Fund.

SPECIFICATIONS

These specifications are intended to cover the furnishing of all materials and the performance of all work that may be required or necessary for the complete performance of the contract, and the bidder will be required to do all things that may be necessary to fully complete the work within the purview of these specifications.

Equipment and/or material to be furnished shall meet with the approval of the Technology Librarian or designated representative.

All equipment and/or material shall conform to the requirements of these specifications, and any equipment and/or material condemned by the Technology Librarian as not meeting these specifications shall at once be removed and replaced with acceptable equipment.

ADDITIONS OR DEDUCTIONS

FRRL shall have the right, without invalidating the contract, to make additions to or make deductions from the work covered by these specifications, and in case such deductions or additions are made, an equitable adjustment of the addition to or deduction in cost shall be made between FRRL and the bidder, as shown in a written amendment to the contract.

PROTECTION BY BIDDER

The bidder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Flint River Regional Library System and their representatives from all suits or actions of every nature and description brought against them or any of them, on account of the use of patented or copyrighted appliances, materials, products or processes, and from all legal expenses and costs of suits regarding the same.

Bidders shall obey all Federal, State, County, and City laws or ordinances in any way pertaining to the work, and shall obtain all permits that may be necessary for its performance if required. (a) That in the hiring of employees for the performance of such contract, no bidder, sub-contractor, nor any person acting on behalf of such bidder or sub-contractor shall by reason of race, creed or color discriminate against any citizen of the United States who is qualified and able to perform the work to which the employment relates; (b) Nor shall they in any manner discriminate against or intimidate any employees hired for the performance of the work on account of race, creed or color. House Bill 87, Section 3, E-verify Form.

All bidders shall not assign, transfer, convey, sublet or otherwise dispose of the contract or any part thereof to anyone without the written consent of the Flint River Regional Library.

RESERVATIONS

FRRL reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and also reserves the right to waive any informality in the proposals received.

Any bidder who has demonstrated poor performance during either a current or previous agreement with FRRL may be considered as an unqualified source and their proposal may be rejected. FRRL reserves the right to exercise this option as is deemed proper and/or necessary.

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BID FORM

Attached to these specifications is "Bid Form-Signature Page" which must be completely filled out and signed by each bidder and included in their RFP submission.

All bids must be sealed, marked, and delivered in accordance with the instructions as in this RFP. Bids will be opened and read by FRRL administrative staff, Technology Librarian, and the Library Business Manager at the closing of the bid due date.

Recommendations will be made and the Executive Director may award a contract or contracts as FRRL deems appropriate.

EXEMPTION FROM GEORGIA SALES TAXES

The Flint River Regional Library is exempt from Georgia State Sales Tax. Net prices as shown in the proposal shall exclude said State tax amounts. Bidders shall inform all prospective subcontractors and suppliers from whom they expect to obtain services or supplies of the tax exempt status of the Flint River Regional Library. Following a contract award, an exemption certificate will be furnished by Flint River Regional Library.
