

## Wireless Network Access

**Note:** Each location of the Flint River Regional Library System has separate policies and procedures regarding the use of their wireless network access. The information listed below is for the Griffin-Spalding County Library. Please call your local library for information regarding the use of their facilities.

The Griffin-Spalding County Library is proud to be able to offer high-speed wireless network access to our patrons. Access is free and getting online is quick and simple. All you need is a wireless-enabled (802.11b or 802.11g compliant) laptop computer, tablet PC or PDA. Your hardware should be able to locate the library's wireless network automatically. No special encryption settings, usernames or passwords are required. If you do not connect automatically, double-check the settings below.

### Quick Settings:

<b>SSID</b>	=	FlintRiverCybrary
<b>WEP</b>	=	disable
<b>DHCP</b>	=	obtain an IP address automatically
<b>DNS</b>	=	obtain DNS address automatically
